DIVISION 1 AND DIVISION 1 RESERVE

- Level and Level 2
- Assistant Referees Course
- Examination: with SARRA Aspirations...National Examination

with NO SARRA Aspirations...Western Province...and / or...SARRA

Exam mark -70%

- Fitness Test -18 YoYo
- Only UNDER 19A SCHOOL MATCHES...will count towards the Referees Assessments
- The Referee must maintain an **average score of a 4 or higher** in order to remain in this Division

DEMOTIONS

- If Referee does not obtain the prescribed criteria levels
- A LOW SCORE ...from the Executive...and...or...Match Reviewers

DIVISION 2 AND DIVISION 2 RESERVE

- Level 1 and Level 2
- Assistant Referees Course
- Examination: with SARRA Aspirations...National Examination

with NO SARRA Aspirations...Western Province...and / or...SARRA

Exam mark -65%

- Fitness Test – 17 YoYo
- Only UNDER 19A SCHOOL MATCHES...will count towards the Referees Assessments
- Minimum of 3 Reports for promotion from Executive...Performance Reviewer...of which at least 2 must be from different matches
- Moving from Division 2 to Division 1: THERE ARE THREE WAYS...Average of the reports must be of a score 5 or higher...OR...x3 Reports closest to date of Performance Review Meeting to be three...(x3)... scores of a 5...OR...delete the highest score and delete the lowest score and now take the average of the reports... is the average a score 5 or higher?
- After achieving the 5 average with the 3 methods of score calculation, the referee will be appointed to a Super League C and Super League B game two weekends in a row. A senior Coach and Match Reviewer will be at each game to assess the referee. For the referee to get promoted to Division 1 he needs to get an average of a 4 for the four reports.
- If the referee does not get a 4 average for the four reports, he stays in Division 2 and the four reports get added to his report summary that will count for the next grading.

NOTES

- *In this Division...Referees must maintain the prescribed fitness test levels for Division 2*
- *In order to be considered for promotion to Division 1...the Referee must ALREADY be running the DIVISION 1 prescribed minimum fitness test levels in this current Division 2*
- *Methods of Score Calculation...in order to be promoted to Division 1... (1) Calculate the average score of the referee's reports...remember the referee requires 3 reports... (2)...Remove the highest mark and remove the lowest mark. Then...obtain an average score of all the remaining reports...remember the referee requires 3 reports...(3) Take the last 3 reports closest to the date of the Match Reviewing Meeting...and...calculate the average score of these x3 reports...and...the average score of these x3 reports must be of a score 5 or higher in order to qualify for promotion*

- The **MAJORITY...of the Reports...**must be a **score of 4 or higher...**to be considered for Promotion

- The **MAJORITY...of the Reports...**must be a **score of 3...**to be considered for Promotion to Division 6
- The **MAJORITY...of the Reports...**must be a **score of 4 or higher.....**to be considered for Promotion **...to any other Division... higher than Division 6**
